Rural Fire: Supervisor Roberts presented the annual fire run report. Eaton Township had 42 structural runs/124 runs total. The price per run will be \$3745.93. Total owed \$157,329.16 The FD currently has 27 volunteers and is need of more volunteers. Runs are already increased over this time last year. The new snorkel truck has been delivered and is being fitted with the apparatus. The Fire Dept would like the townships to adopt a new fire code they will share in the future.
